- ❖ Exodus 12; 1400 B.C.
- ❖ 10th plague against Egypt: all firstborn will die
- ❖ Kill a lamb; put blood on doorframe of house
- ❖ The Lord will "pass over" that house
- ❖ Families roast the lamb; eat it and unleavened bread
- ❖ A memorial feast established
